Authors are permitted to remove or blind author-identifying information (author names and affiliations, obvious self-references) from their submissions, if they choose to do so. Removed or blinded author-identifying information must be submitted separately as directed on the electronic submission web page. The proceedings will be published by Springer-Verlag in their Lecture Notes in Computer Science series and will be available at the conference. Exceptional conference papers will also be solicited for submission to a special issue of the International Journal of Information Security.
